Guidelines for Parents

- 1. Retina is that sensitive membrane of eye, through which we can see things.
- 2. In premature babies, normal growth of blood vessels that bring blood to the Retina gets affected. This is called Retinopathy Of Prematurity (ROP).
- 3. Babies born before 32 weeks of gestation and weighing 1500 gms or less at birth, are at risk of developing ROP.
- 4. Babies who were born before 35 weeks of gestation and had received oxygen for any duration, are also at risk of developing ROP.
- 5. It is necessary for every premature baby to get a detailed check up and screening examination for ROP at four weeks of age.
- 6. If baby develops ROP, he/she can have major complications including:

Nearsightedness (difficulty in seeing things far away); Amblyopia (weak vision in one eye); Strabismus (misalignment of the eyes); Blindness.

7. It is extremely important for parents of premuture babies to take their baby to the eye consultant for ROP screening at the given appointment.
