Intelligence quotient (IQ) is a measure of a person's cognitive abilities, including their reasoning, problem-solving, memory, and verbal and mathematical skills. The evaluation of one's IQ involves a meticulous process conducted by qualified psychologists, employing a range of standardized tests such as the Slosson Intelligence Test, Reynold Intelligence Assessment Scale, Vineland Adaptive Behaviour Scale, Wide Range Achievement Test, and Conners. Each of these tests holds distinct implications for a child's learning journey. Administered for children aged six years and older, these assessments require a referral from the child's healthcare provider, teachers, and/or school management. The ultimate goal of IQ testing is to furnish a numerical score, offering insight into an individual's intellectual standing relative to the broader population.

What is Included in the package:

- 3 sessions with a psychologist.
- Session time may vary from 45 to 90 minutes.
- A report will be provided within 30 days.

What is Included in the package:

- Helps understand the individual's cognitive abilities.
- Helps identify strengths and weaknesses, and personal development.

Confidentiality and Privacy:

The report will only be accessible to the psychologist performing the assessment and the parents.
