



**Specimen Collection and Transportation Information**

- **Preparation of the Patient:** Sterile preparation of the wound site is need
- **Type of Collection Container:** Wide mouth Plastic Container
- **Types and Amounts of Preservatives or Anticoagulants:** 10% buffered formalin 10 times volume of the specimen
- **Quantity of Specimen to be Collected:**
  - **Minimum Quantity:** Single punch biopsy usually suffices
- **Transportation Temperature:** Room Temperature
- **Need for Special Timing for Collection (where applicable):** NA
- **Specimen Stability Information:** Should be immerse in formalin
- **Special Instruction:** Not recommended on Face/Chest. Site must be marked by primary physician.
- **Rejection Criteria:** Without formalin/Without history
- **Need for Appropriate Clinical Data, When Indicated (Patient history):** Complete clinical history along with mark on skin
