- **Preparation of the Patient:** NA
- **Type of Collection Container:** Plain tube or Gel Tube ( yellow top)
- **Types and Amounts of Preservatives or Anticoagulants:** NA
- **Quantity of Specimen to be Collected:** 3-5cc
  - **Minimum Quantity:** 3cc
- **Transportation Temperature:** 18-25°C for 8 hours, 2-8 °C after 8 hours to 3 days , after 3 days at – 20°C
- **Need for Special Timing for Collection (where applicable):** NA
- **Specimen Stability Information:** If the assay is performed within 72 hours of sample collection, the samples should be kept at 2-8°C; otherwise they should be aliquotted and stored deep-frozen (–20°C or below) for longer periods.
